## COST

- Prices vary by design, size, and location. All bookings require a non-refundable deposit.
- Pricing shown does not include WA state sales tax which is required by law for tattoo services.
- All tattoo prices shown are for black ink. Any upgrades such as pink or red floral instead of black etc. will be an additional charge of \$10.
- Prices shown are when in my studio. Any event or location change will be an up charge depending on a variety of factors.

Healed results are dependent upon a variety of factors including lifestyle, health conditions, following proper aftercare, etc.

Did you know that in WA state you are not required to get any schooling or training to become a microblading artist? Most aren't aware of this and choose artists without doing their due diligenc. I trained under some of the best instructors and a world renowned program for almost a year in the art of all things eyebrows and microblading and shading. I have now been an artist for three years and am learning and growing in my skillset each day.

I specialize in natural, healed results. I customize each clients brows to their bone structure and liking. After all, what's cool and in style today isn't what will be in style tomorrow. Additionally, natural will always be in style.

The three eyebrow services I offer are Microblading, Powder Ombré, and Combo Brows.

Brow Services
EXPLANATION AND DETAILS

#### **MICROBLADING**

Microblading is the original manual brow technique that uses a superfine row of needles to deposit pigments into the skin to create thin, hair-like strokes. Microblading is ideal for creating a very natural and realistic looking brow. It does **not** mimic the look of makeup or even natural makeup. Microblading is best suited for those with dry to normal skin, and who have naturally fuller eyebrows with no major asymmetry. This technique heals very natural, so it's perfect for youthful skin that wants to stay very fresh faced and natural for longer!

Usually lasts between 1-2 years before needing a touch up.

### **POWDER OMBRÉ**

This technique mimics the 'effect' you achieve when you use a brow powder. It offers a more defined appearance as the pigment is applied using a machine and a technique that covers the brow area from the inner brow through to the tail. These small pigment pixels, add depth, definition, and results in a more 'makeup tinted' look. Powder/Ombré brows can be as dramatic or as natural as your prefer. Powder/Ombré brows heals best on most skin types including oily skin, last longer than microblading, and requires less upkeep. Additionally, this technique is recommended to those with more mature skin. The ombré effect is due to the brows starting very light at the front of the brows and gradually getting darker at the tails.

Usually lasts 1-3 years before needing a touch up.

### **COMBINATION "COMBO"**

Combo brows are a combination of microbladed hair strokes and a powdery ombré tale. Microblading can be added to the front of the brows leading into the body or throughout the entire brow. Shading is typically added to the tail end of the brow and slowly transitioning into the strokes, or can be added in-between strokes to add density. This technique is great for those of you who use a brow powder or pencil. Best suited for people with combination skin types, yet suitable for all skin types.

Usually lasts 1-3 years before needing a touch up.

# **REQUIREMENTS**

18 years + and not currently taking any medications/antibiotics or other autoimmune suppressant medications. Not currently pregnant or breastfeeding. No active infections at time of appointment. No upcoming surgeries within 4 weeks. Not currently on blood thinning medications. All diabetics should refrain from tattoos unless you have a doctor's note giving the okay. No past history of keloid scarring. Not on accutane for past 6 months. No botox in last 30 days or next 30 days. History of cancer - must be a minimum 6 months after final treatments and have a doctor's note okaying the service.

No alcohol 24 hours prior to appointment No caffeine prior to appointment. No advil/tylenol 24 hours prior to appointment. Stop taking fish oil 4 days prior to appointment. These things will cause extra bleeding and will push the pigment out immediately making me have to stop your service and rescheduling.
